

Sackville Minor Hockey Club 50/50 Fundraiser

Instruction Sheet for Hockey Parents

How does the 50/50 program work?

- Weekly draws, on **Wednesday** night, where **50% goes to the winner**, 20% to the minor hockey player's registration, and 30% to SMHC. If the number drawn is not played, draws continue until a played number is drawn.

How does the 50/50 program benefit SMHC players and the Club?

- There are hockey players within SMHC that do **NOT** pay any registration fees!

- The 30% that the club receives helps pay for ice time and helps keep registration fees to a minimum.

How do I recruit lottery players?

- The form, on the reverse of this sheet, is completed and returned to you, or placed in the Minor Hockey binder at any one of the stores listed below.
- Lottery players are assigned a number by the 50/50 fundraising committee. Must be 19 years of age.

Methods of Payment

- 1\$ a week to play!
- You can choose to collect money from your lottery players or they may pay, themselves, weekly at Turner's Kwik Way, Sassy's, the Esso, Middle Sackville Variety, the Ultramar, Backlot Video or Mel's Tearoom by Monday at 6pm. Lottery players can **play** weekly or pre-pay for as many weeks in advance as they wish.
- ***Prepayment is preferable for 2 reasons: firstly, you are guaranteed to have played each week (if you forget to pay for a week and your number is drawn, you do not win!); secondly, this makes less "paperwork" for the volunteers running the 50/50.***
- Cash and cheques (including post-dated) are acceptable methods of payment.
